The Trinity 'Yakers kayaking group took advantage of the beautiful fall weather this past Saturday to embark on their second voyage.



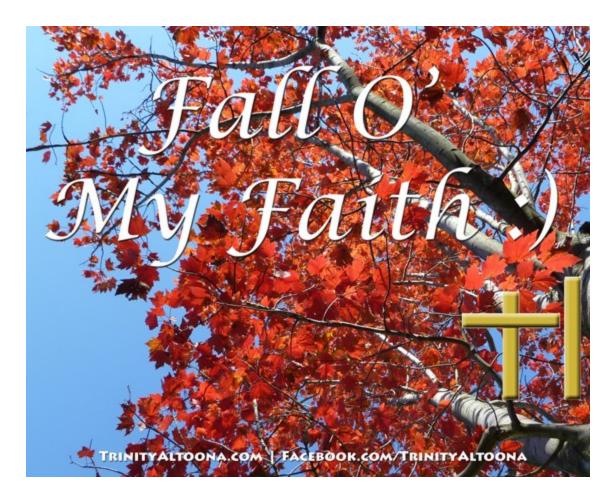
The 'Yakers kicked things off in August with a trip down the Raystown branch of the Juniata River. This time the group checked out the lake at Shawnee State Park near Bedford.
