Julie Anthony, a Florida resident who has family in Hollidaysburg, came to Trinity Altoona recently to discuss the Imani Milele mission in Uganda.



Ms. Anthony met with the Trinity Stitchers sewing group and explained how she became involved in missions work following the tragic death of her granddaughter and a medical mission trip to a primary school in Uganda. She talked about the kids having to walk 15 miles a day through cane fields and dirt paths, just to get to and from school.

Julie's fundraising work has helped pay for a new school building and provide sewing machines, books and hygiene supplies.

The Stitches group was very impressed with Julie's efforts to help the children of Uganda. They presented her with 50 girls' dresses and 15 boys' outfits which she will deliver to the mission next year.



According to Stitcher Lois Gutshall, Julie's talk about the true needs in Uganda really brings home the message "in so much you have done it to the least of these, you have done it to me."

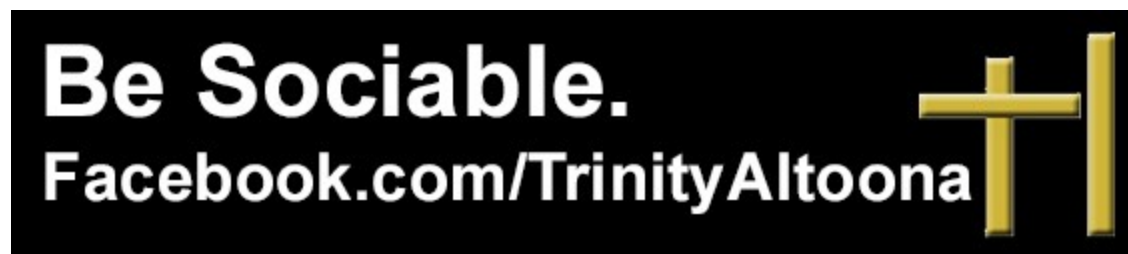
