ATTENDANCE STEADY AT TRINITY ALTOONA

After being closed to the public for three months due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Trinity Altoona saw a steady number of worshipers from Week 1 to Week 2 of our reopening. A combined total of 85 people have attended worship services each of the past two weekends, a healthy turnout as we officially enter summer.

Pastor Eli's sermon this past weekend was all about Father's Day and the rollercoaster

As we continue moving back to normal, the church is being cleaned and prepared prior to each weekend and then refreshed after each of our 3 weekly services: 6:30PM Saturday, 8:15AM Sunday and 10:45AM Sunday.

We are, of course, taking a common sense approach and applying recommended social distancing measures during worship services. The 6th Street door is not currently being used so we can reduce the number of entry points to the church. There is also no singing, passing of the peace, communion etc. for the time being.

LATE BREAKING NEWS!

Your church council met last night to discuss our strategy for resuming other activities at Trinity Altoona. Here is what was decided by council:

- Activities including Adult Bible Study, Crochet Group, the Healthy You
 Program and Sewing Group will be allowed to resume in July. Participation is up to the members of each group, so long as they follow social distancing guidelines and do a cleaning of their meeting area afterwards
- Communion will resume the weekend of July 4-5 during all 3 services, then only at the Sunday 8:15AM service for the remainder of the month. It will be a continuous communion format, allowing for social distancing
- Vacation Bible School and our annual Church Picnic will not be held this year
