The Orbit

A congregational meeting was held at all 3 worship services the weekend of Aug 1-2 to approve changes to Trinity's gift acceptance policy. The congregation approved that all undesignated gifts to the congregation would be divided 50:50 between the general fund and the endowment fund.

It should be emphasized that this applies only to UNDESIGNATED GIFTS. THE WISHES OF THE DONOR ARE ALWAYS PARAMOUNT. Gifts may be specified for the general fund, the endowment fund, or for any specific purpose. It should be remembered that gifts for specific purpose(s) may be returned to the general fund if not used after a period of time.

The special Thank Offering for September resulted in \$368.00 being given towards the Youth Expo (which has been rescheduled for 2022 due to Covid-19) Thanks to all who supported this endeavor for our youth to travel to what past attendees have described as a life-changing experience.

The next Thank Offering will be in November. Council has decided to designate this offering for St. Andrew's preschool. St. Andrew's is always in need of supplies and the teachers often give of their own money to purchase them. Please consider supporting this part of our ministry and remember to use the Thank Offering envelope or otherwise separate this from your regular offering.

Greetings/Devotions

The meeting was called to order by Vice President, Linda Hoover Pastor led us with prayer.

Minutes from last meeting.

Minutes from June 23 were read. Adam made a motion to approve the minutes. Tom seconded the motion. Motion passed.

The minutes will be put in the Orbit for the congregation to read.

Treasurer's Report

Ralph presented the report as written. Pastor's health insurance is all that is due. He stated that from January 1 through August 14, \$1300.00 was deposited into the Endowment Fund. The balance of the Endowment Fund is \$24,390.78. We need to reach \$27,000.00 in order to invest the money and have \$2,000.00 for a 10% to an ELCA ministry.

Balance in the Investments as of the end of July is \$210,657.93.

Ralph stated that there may be another endowment fund that was started in 2003. He plans to talk to the investment bank in Indiana to check on this.

A question was asked how has our offering been? More was received when we were closed. However, some are still sending in their gifts if they are not attending.

Ralph and Tom are working to put the files into the computer system. They will upgrade the system to 2020 before they input the files.

John E. questioned the 10% of gifts going to the ELCA ministry. Does that include Memorial Gifts and Endowment Gifts? The way the current Gift Acceptance Policy is written, half of gifts would go to the General Fund and half to the Endowment unless otherwise stated. Ralph expressed concern why the Treasurer was not included in the discussions with the Endowment Committee. John also asked if the policy was sent out to the members of the congregation before the meeting. It was.

Pastor will look over the Gift Acceptance Policy and the Endowment Policy for our next meeting.

Bill made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Tom seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Pastor presented her written report.
