

Greetings/Devotions

The meeting was called to order by President, Linda Hoover Pastor led us with prayer.

Minutes from last meeting.

Minutes from December 15 were read. Adam made a motion to accept the minutes. Geri seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report

Ralph presented the report as written. All is up to date except the payroll. The quarterly taxes are paid. The local taxes are yet to be paid. He is working on W2's and will have them out this week. Offerings continue to come in. John questioned the special offering listed in the report of \$1,990.00. These were special Christmas envelopes. Adam made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Ash Wednesday is approaching, and she will be preaching about the journey of the exodus for the Wednesday services during Lent.

In person worship services: we discussed beginning in person worship the first weekend in February with Sunday School beginning the following week. John presented a graph showing the COVID-19 percentages in Blair County. In January we were at 20%. Now we are at 7.9%. It is in a downward trend. Following discussion, it was decided to begin worship the first weekend in February with Sunday School beginning the following week. Tom Settle will continue to record the announcements and sermon to be posted on Facebook. We will continue social distancing, wearing face masks and cleaning after each service. Church activities will also be resuming. Barb made a motion to accept the proposal. Adam seconded the motion. Motion passed. St. Andrew Preschool will begin February 1.

Counting schedule: Barb reviewed the schedule and asked that all Council members sign up if they are willing and able. It is good for members to know the finances of the church.

Committees: Sharon reviewed the committee appointments.
