Greetings/Devotions

The meeting was called to order by President, Linda Hoover Pastor led us with prayer.

Tom took care of the Atlantic BB subscription. Ralph said it will be deducted directly from the checking account. Barb checked on the funds in the Special Offerings. It seems that all special items (flowers, bulletins, special offerings) are being lumped together. These need to be separated. She will hold a Finance meeting to discuss separating accounts.

Geri asked if all the fire inspection concerns have been addressed. Pastor said they have and the Fire Inspector is coming this Friday to recheck.

Sharon asked why the lights in Trinity Hall have not been replaced. Pastor said that when they burn out the ballast is being replaced with LED lights. Adam will take care of this.

Endowment papers: Pastor has all the paperwork completed but needs three signatures. Pastor, Ralph (Treasurer) and Linda (President). Now Pastor will go to a Notary and sign the papers. The papers will then be sent to ELCA to get an account number. Once we have the account number, we will then send a form with our check to be invested.

New Business

Distancing and mask protocol: Pastor stated that the tape was taken off the pews and people were still social distancing. Following a discussion about mask wearing, it was agreed to continue the masks and reevaluate at the next council meeting. Sharon made a motion to continue the masks and reevaluate at the next council meeting. Adam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Sharon took up a collection from Council for Ken Myer's mother in law, Phylis Wright.

Boy Scouts: Matt Hale has asked if the Boy Scouts could hold a breakfast in the fall and at Christmas time. Council had already approved spaghetti dinners for the scouts. The breakfasts will be approved also.

Greetings/Devotions

The meeting was called to order by President, Linda Hoover Pastor led us with prayer.

Minutes from last meeting.

Minutes from March 23rd were read. Adam made a motion to accept the minutes. Judy seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report

Ralph presented the report as written. \$465.00 was sent to the Agarwal Center (Teen Center) from the Thank Offering in February. \$300.00 was given to St. Andrew Preschool. \$460.00 has come in for the Endowment. This will be deposited quarterly.

Ralph also posted the 2021 posters in the church. Judy made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report. Adam seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Marianne Brock, ELCA to discuss the Endowment Fund.

Marianne told us a bit of her personal background. Her job is to 1. Help congregations invest funds, 2. Work with individuals to set up plans, and 3. To work on behalf of the Allegheny Synod.

The Endowment Fund of ELCA has been around for a long time. Its name has changed from Fund A to Ministry Growth Fund. It is an investment created by ELCA for ELCA. It is a co-mingled fund. There are two goals: to support ministry and to stabilize quarterly distributions for investors. At the beginning of the year, we will get a statement with the stable distribution rate which does not rise and fall with the market. The investment follows the ELCA guidelines. Investment managers are top firms managing the investment. When our money is invested, it is our money. Quarterly comment cards are sent with a monthly fact sheet. Each quarter investment meetings are online and available to anyone. This is not a high-risk investment. We are in it for long term at 4% annual return. Quarterly distributions can be taken or reinvested to take later.

The next step, she will send forms to the church or John to fill out an application to create an account and number. Then we will send our check in to be invested. To add to the account, we need increments of \$2,000.00. Any gift over \$5,000.00, 10% will be set aside to ELCA ministry. It is our discretion what to send it to.

We thanked Marianne for taking the time to come and explain the fund and our next step. She also said she would come back anytime if needed.

Pastor Hess' Report

Presented as written. She discussed Lent and Easter services. She discussed vaccines and homes opening up for visitation. Bible Study and Adult Sunday School is going well.

Committee Reports Presented as written.

Old Business

Adam put up a handicap bar in the women's bathroom and a handrail in the Sacristy.

John stated that Sandy came up with two proposals for the rail in the Sanctuary by the Cry Room. An oak railing with spindles costs \$1000.00 to \$1300.00. An oak wall similar to the one on the choir loft, costs \$500.00 to \$800.00. Concern is matching the stain and finish. We will also need to check ADA guidelines and fire regulations for the opening.

We have received a gift of \$1000.00 from Gary Crownover for this project in memory of his wife and sister. John will get back to Sandy and have more information at the next meeting.

New Business

Tom checked with Atlantic BB to renew our subscription. If we do nothing it increases to \$132.00/month. If we subscribe for 3-year contract with better service, it will be \$148.00. Sharon made a motion to accept the 3-year contract. Barb seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Pastor will be taking vacation from June 14-21. Peggy Thatcher will be covering services. No communion.

Debbie announced that our florist, City View Florist, is going out of business. She investigated other florists in town and recommended to go with Peterman's. They will honor the price we are currently paying, \$40.00. Sharon made a motion to accept Peterman's. Geri seconded the motion. Motion passed with one opposition.

The meeting was then adjourned.

We closed with the Lord's Prayer.
