FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT

I am pleased to report that after a delay of over a year, the insurance carrier for the gas company has offered to reimburse Trinity for the extensive water damage caused by their excavation on the 5 th Avenue side of the building.

Some of the delay was due to a lot of back and forth between the gas company and the firm that they had subcontracted the digging to. Cleanup alone from the water and mud that came into the basement totaled over \$13,000. It's certainly a relief to have this matter finally settled. In other "money matters", a copy of the budget for 2023 has been included with the Orbit this month. If you did not receive one, copies are available at the church.

The finance committee worked diligently to construct a budget that will enable Trinity to continue its ministries. This included some overdue salary increases for Trinity staff. Please review the budget before the Annual Congregational Meeting the weekend of Nov. 19-20. This budget will require an increase in expenditures, and I realize that finances are under strain at this point. Please consider making a small increase in your weekly offering. Also, Trinity needs some folks willing to serve on Council. There are some demands on your time to serve on Council, but your input is needed and welcomed. If you can't make the commitment to serve on Council, please consider serving on one of the committees. It is up to all of us to help Trinity grow and thrive.

recommendations, please send them before the meeting.


The meeting was then adjourned.
